## **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) Programme in Education**

The Doctoral Programme in Department of Education is a full time course offered after Master's/M.Phil. Degree.

The Doctoral Programme in Education aims to develop a systematic understanding of research in education by unfolding its various dimensions as an organized area of study. The program envisages to prepare the scholars to undertake a systematized enquiry and orient them to study, design, and examine problems in education both, conceptually and empirically. It offers an opportunity for scholars to interact and learn from faculty from diverse disciplines of Education. The doctoral programme carries a holistic and inclusive approach towards the multi-dimensional nature of education in today's globalized world. It allows an in-depth study in the core and perspective areas of education such as, educational theory, foundational areas of education, educational practice and policy related concerns in education. It also comprises a systematic introduction to courses in research methodology which will enable the scholars to undertake qualitative, longitudinal, ethnographic, phenomenological, comparative, and quantitative work in education as an area of study.

The course-work gives scholars an opportunity to study individualized courses customized to suit their research interests. These could be a combination of courses designed within the Department of Education and those chosen from courses across disciplines offered by other departments of the University of Delhi. The doctoral program intends to develop a fraternity of scholars and professionals with significant critical, analytical, divergent and synthesizing abilities, who can develop specialised knowledge in the field of education. The programme prepares the scholars to assume roles as teacher educators, researchers, consultants, educational leaders, professional practitioners, and policy makers.

### **ELEGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

#### **Candidates for admission to the Ph.D. Programme shall have successfully completed:**

Master's degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate (or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7- point scale or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose or assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/differently-abled and other categories or candidates eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. coursework with at least 55% marks in aggregate (or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and have successfully completed the M.Phil. degree with at least 55% marks shall be eligible for appearing directly for interview. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/differently-abled.

Candidates who have cleared coursework of M.Phil. from University of Delhi with at least 55% marks in aggregate may directly appear for interview to Ph.D. without completing the M.Phil. Dissertation. if the candidate is interested in registering for Ph.D. "without completing M.Phil. Programme.

A candidate who's M.Phil. dissertation has been evaluated and the viva voce is pending may appear directly for interview to the Ph.D. programme.

Candidates possessing a degree considered equivalent to M.Phil. Degree of an Indian Institution with 55% marks or from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme.

***Note: Rounding off of fraction is not allowed while computing the percentage of marks of eligibility.***

### **Admission Procedure for Ph.D Programme:**

All the candidates seeking admission to the Ph.D. Program are required to register online on <http://phd2023.uod.ac.in>. Click Help tab on the Portal to view the Step by Step Instructions to fill the Application Form.

- Please ascertain that all the details given in the form are complete and correct, because the same will be used throughout the admission procedure.
- Admission to all Ph.D. Programs are done on the basis of the eligibility criteria and procedures specified by the University on its website, Ph.D Bulletin of Information - 2023 (Ph.D-BOI). Before initiating the registration process, the candidates must read the contents of PhD BOI-2023 and consult the Delhi University Act, 1922, its amendments and the Statutes. The Ordinances, Rules, Regulations, and Notifications of the UoD available on the University of Delhi website, [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in) shall be final and binding.
- Candidates seeking admission in Ph.D. Program must go through **Clause C “Eligibility Criteria”** of Notification: Amendments to Ordinances dated 09th August, 2017 and its Amendments approved by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 01-02.07.2019 to check if they are exempted from appearing in the Entrance Test (Annexure-I & II). However, **interview is mandatory for all Candidates**.

- Admission to all Ph.D. Programs is done online through the University's portal <http://phd2023.uod.ac.in>.
- In **Phase I**, only the candidates who are eligible on the basis of qualifying UGC-NET (including JRF)/ UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/ AYUSH-NET/DBT-JRF, ICMR-JRF, DST-INSPIRE or equivalent national level examination/fellowship (as identified by DRC)/ GATE/ teacher fellowship holders and others (as per Ordinance VI, Notification: Amendments to Ordinances dated 09th August, 2017 and its Amendments approved by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 01-02.07.2019) will be able to apply.
- In **Phase II**, all eligible candidates will be able to apply. However, candidates who become eligible on the basis of appearing in the entrance test will be shortlisted for interviews after the declaration of the result of the entrance test.

- Supernumerary seats shall be available as per the University rules. Teachers, who are in service in the University of Delhi, **may directly appear for interview**. These will be supernumerary seats.

- Applicants are required to upload their Research area and Research proposal while registering online. **Applications without Research Area/proposal will be considered incomplete and rejected**

#### **Registration Fees:**

Registration fee (**non-refundable**) for the Ph.D. program is as follows:

- Reserved- SC/ST/ PwBD - Rs. 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred Only)
- Unreserved- UR/EWS/OBC-NCL- Rs.750/- (Rupees Seven Hundred and Fifty Only)

**Mode of Payment** - Net Banking, Debit Card, Credit Card, and UPI

**University will not refund Admission Fee (if paid) in case any candidate is found ineligible at any stage.**

#### **Ph.D. Selection Process:**

**The selection process will be as per the minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed in the Ph.D Bulletin of Information - 2023 (Ph.D-BOI), University of Delhi.**

- Admission to all Ph.D. Programs is done online through the University's portal <http://phd2023.uod.ac.in>.
- Candidates with Masters or equivalent degree must appear in an entrance test. **The entrance test will be a qualifying examination with 50% as the qualifying marks for candidates belonging to the unreserved category.**
- A relaxation of 5% of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non-Creamy layers)/ Differently-abled category in the entrance examination conducted by the University as per the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./ Ph.D. Degrees) (1st Amendment) Regulations, 2018.
- **The shortlisted candidates on the basis of the entrance test shall appear for an interview.** Please visit the University of Delhi Ph.D. admission portal [www.admission.uod.ac.in](http://www.admission.uod.ac.in)
- Candidates who have qualified UGC-NET (including JRF)/ UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/ AYUSH-NET/DBT-JRF, ICMR-JRF, DST-INSPIRE or equivalent national level examination/fellowship (as identified by DRC)/GATE/teacher fellowship holder may **directly appear for interview**.
- The selection of the candidates to the Ph.D. Programme is made on the basis of the entrance test and the interview conducted by the Department of Education, University of Delhi.

- The minimum aggregate needed in the entrance test to qualify for the Interview is 50% marks **for candidates belonging to the unreserved category.**
- The list of shortlisted candidates and dates of the interview shall be notified on the Ph.D. admission portal of the University of Delhi and Department of Education website [www.admission.uod.ac.in](http://www.admission.uod.ac.in) and <http://cie.du.ac.in>
- The submission of Research Proposal is mandatory for the Ph.D. Program.
- Eligibility for appearing in the written examination/ interview is subject to the candidate fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed in the Ph.D Bulletin of Information - 2023 (Ph.D-BOI). If at any stage, documents submitted by the candidate relating to the admission are found to be fake/non genuine and/or fabricated or in any other manner defective, the said candidate will not be given admission and if already admitted, admission will be canceled without any prior notice in this regard. If the same is found after completing the Program, his/her degree will be revoked and appropriate legal action will be taken against him/her.
- A candidate's participation in the admission process will be provisional. If, at any stage, it is found that eligibility requirements are not fulfilled, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled ipso facto and appropriate legal action will be taken against such candidate.

### **Ph.D Entrance Examination/Test**

The Entrance Test will be a qualifying examination with qualifying marks as 50%. The syllabus for the entrance test will consists of 50% questions on research aptitude/methodology and 50% subject-specific questions.

**A relaxation of 5% of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy layers)/Differently-abled category in the entrance examination** conducted by the University as per the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degrees) (1st Amendment) Regulations, 2018.

### **Interview**

**The candidates will have to appear in person for two rounds of interview to be held in the Department of Education. The candidates are advised to regularly check the departmental website for the announcement of dates of the interviews.**

- The submission of Research Proposal (to be submitted at the time of online registration) is mandatory for the Ph.D. Program. A Candidate needs to provide the following details:
  - i. Your proposed theme and scope of research for Ph.D.
  - ii. The major writings in the field in which you would like to pursue your Ph.D.? If you have made any original contributions in the field of proposed research then mention it.
  - iii. Primary sources/field work, methodology, hypothesis /research, questions and issues in the proposed field of interest (approx. 2500words).
  - iv. Past Research Experience, Publications (if any)
  - v. Additional Information

**The research proposal in Hindi should be typed in Unicode/Mangal, Font size 14 and line spacing 1.5 and the Research proposal in English should be typed in Times New Roman, Font size 12 and line Spacing 1.5**

At the time of interview, the candidates are required to discuss/defend their research interest/area through a presentation before a Committee/Board at the Department of Education, University of Delhi.

**Note: The Admission to Ph.D. Program of University of Delhi is governed by the Ordinance VI dated 9 August 2017 and its subsequent amendments of the University of Delhi published on the University of Delhi website, [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in) from time to time in this regard.**

### **Reservation of Seats/ Relaxations/Concessions:**

**Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/ PwBD candidates and registration of foreign nationals will be done as per Rules & Norms of University of Delhi.**

- 22.5% of the total number of seats are reserved for Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (15% for Scheduled Caste and 7.5% for Scheduled Tribes, inter-changeable if necessary).
- 27% of seats are reserved for Candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes (OBC - Non- Creamy Layer)
- The University have reserved 10% seats for admission of candidates belonging to EWS category
- **Supernumerary seats shall be made available as per the rules/norms of University of Delhi**
- A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/differently-abled and other categories or candidates eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.
- The merit list for the UR category seats will comprise all candidates in order of merit. No one will be excluded from the same. In other words, the merit list for the Unreserved (UR) category will also include SC/ST/OBCNCL/ EWS candidates, irrespective of category, if they meet the criterion of merit for the UR category. No candidate can be excluded from the UR category merit list just because the Candidate

belongs to or has applied under SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS category. Discrimination on the basis of category/ caste is completely unlawful. The University of Delhi does not tolerate discrimination against any Candidate/student on this basis. Strict action will be taken against any violations.

- If the total number of eligible ST category candidates who have applied for particular Ph.D. Program exhausts, then the remaining seats under this category will be allocated to eligible SC category candidates and vice-versa.

- **The Admission to Ph.D. Program of University of Delhi is governed by the Ordinance VI dated 9 August 2017 and its subsequent amendments of the University of Delhi published on the University of Delhi website, [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in) from time to time in this regard.**
- Admission of the candidate to the Ph.D. Program is based on the suitability to specific specializations and also subject to fulfilling all other conditions laid down in the respective Ordinances of the University of Delhi.
- The merit list of the recommended candidates shall be displayed on the website after approval by the DRC/BRS. There will be a waiting list in the order of merit.
- **The scores of the entrance test will be valid only for the admissions of the current academic year.**

- The DRC/BRS reserves the right not to select candidates for all the vacancies advertised. The Department reserves the right not to fill all the vacant seats of the Ph.D. Programs in case of non-availability of suitable candidate as per the ordinances of University of Delhi.
- **Seats mentioned in the Ph.D. Bulletin of Information 2023-24 may vary.**
- The registration of candidates in the Ph.D. programme may be confirmed by the BRS based on the recommendation of the DRC after completion of their coursework.
- At the time of admission, the candidate will be required to appear in person at the department for verification of the original documents. The Departments will verify the certificates/ documents submitted by the candidates before granting the admission.
- A candidate's participation in the admission process will be provisional. If, at any stage, it is found that eligibility requirements are not fulfilled, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled ipso facto and appropriate legal action will be taken against such candidate.
- Non-compliance with the requirements for admission, including non-submission of relevant documents and/or non-payment of Fee/s within the stipulated date and time, the candidate will lose his/her right to admission.
- If at any stage, documents submitted by the candidate relating to the admission are found to be fake/non genuine and/or fabricated or in any other manner defective, the said candidate will not be given admission and if already admitted, admission will be canceled without any prior notice in this regard. If the same is found after completing the Program, his/her degree will be revoked and appropriate legal action will be taken against him/her. **The legal jurisdiction of any dispute shall be limited to Delhi only.**
