RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR
STUDENTS' PANCHAYAT ELECTION FOR 2024-2025

1. All bonafide B.Ed. and M.Ed. students for the academic session 2024-2025 would be eligible as voters. Only B.Ed. & M.Ed. students are eligible for contesting for the Panchayat Posts.
2. One person can stand for one post only.
3. Only two Voters can propose, the candidates for contest the election as a candidate. Outsiders are not allowed in election companying.
4. Elected office Bearers would hold office for one academic Session (2024-2025).
5. Each voter has to sign the voter list at the time for getting the ballot paper. The ballot paper should not be taken outside the polling booth (Assembly Hall) under any circumstances.
6. Put a Tick (√) with blue/black pen clearly in the given space against the name of the candidate you wish to vote for. The Tick Mark (√) should not be placed over the name of the candidate. If you put the Tick Mark (√) on more than one name for each post or overlap/any mark, the vote would be counted as invalid for that post.
7. Do not alter or erase Tick Mark (√) after you have put it on the ballot paper.
8. Do not put your signature or disclose your identity on the ballot paper.
9. Fold your ballot paper and put it in the appropriate ballot box.
10. Do not spoil your ballot paper, second ballot paper will not be issued in any case.
11. A ballot paper must bear the signature of either of the following Returning Officers – i) Mr. D.S. Chandi (T.A Comp.) & ii) Mrs. Deepika Sharma (J.A.)
12. Contravention of the rules will render a ballot paper invalid.
13. Only the candidates/authorized agent, who is a bonafide students will be allowed to be present on the stage at the time of counting of votes.
14. Voting through online mode/ Posting ballot is not allowed, only physical mode is allowed.
15. Defacing the walls of CIE by pasting posters is not allowed. Candidates may use the Bulletin Boards/Notice Boards placed inside the CIE premises to put up their manifestoes. Candidates may use old newspapers/waste paper etc. for making posters.
16. In case of a tie for any post, the toss of the coin will decide the elected candidate.
17. Any controversial matter related to the election will be referred to the Office of The Election Officer and Panchayat Convenor.
