<u>RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR</u> STUDENTS' PANCHAYAT ELECTION FOR 2025-2026

November 06, 2025

- All bonafide ITEP, B.Ed. and M.Ed. students for the academic session 2025-2026 would be eligible as voters. Only ITEP, B.Ed. and M.Ed. students are eligible to contest for the Panchayat Posts.
- One person can stand for one post only.
- Only two Voters can propose, and the candidates contest the election as candidates. Outsiders are not allowed in the election campaigning.
- Elected office Bearers would hold office for one academic Session (2025-2026).
- Each voter has to sign the voter list at the time of getting the ballot paper. The ballot paper should not be taken outside the polling booth (Assembly Hall) under any circumstances.
- Put a Tick (✓) with a blue/black pen clearly in the given space against the name of the candidate you wish to vote for. The Tick Mark (✓) should not be placed over the name of the candidate. If you put the Tick Mark (✓) on more than one name for each post or overlap/any mark, the vote would be counted as invalid for that post.
- Do not alter or erase the Tick Mark (✓) after you have put it on the ballot paper.
- Do not put your signature or disclose your identity on the ballot paper.
- Fold your ballot paper and put it in the appropriate ballot box.
- Do not spoil your ballot paper; the second ballot paper will not be issued in any case.
- A ballot paper must bear the signature of either of the following Returning Officers 1st Mr. G.D. Som (AR Edu.) & 2nd Mr. Jagvir Singh (S.O.).
- Contravention of the rules will render a ballot paper invalid.
- Only the candidates/authorized agent, who are a bonafide student, will be allowed to be present on the stage at the time of counting of votes.
- Voting through online mode/ Posting ballot is not allowed; only the physical mode is allowed.
- Defacing the walls of CIE by pasting posters is not allowed. Candidates may use the Bulletin Boards/Notice Boards located within the CIE premises to display their manifestos.
 Candidates may use old newspapers/waste paper, etc., to make posters.
- In the event of any act of violence committed by a candidate during the election, their candidature shall stand cancelled.
- In case of a tie for any post, the toss of the coin will decide the elected candidate.
- Any controversial matter related to the election will be referred to the Office of the Election Officer and Panchayat Convenor.

• Nomination of the candidate depends on final screening of election officer as per the guidelines of University of Delhi.
